Everything we weave begins with TerraStrand, the name of our proprietary extruded yarns. We develop the colors of each yarn for every weave we design, and we have the unique ability to extrude two colors within a single strand of yarn. These extraordinary "bi-color" yarns are used strategically when designing a weave, so that colors seem to appear and disappear, providing subtle shading, depth, and dimension.









Rethinking Green


























Out of the Blue






























Real Reds










The Power of Pink






























New Neutrals
































Mastering Monochrome


