






Easy maintenance.


Enduring aesthetics.

Designed with both beauty and function in mind, Chilewich textiles retain their distinctive colors and rich textures over many years of use. "We don't see a wear pattern or change of coloring, even where the traffic is heaviest," notes Carvalho.

It has proved especially valuable in renovation projects. According to Nisbet, "The woven texture helped to hide imperfections of the floor underneath."



Noise reduction.

"Chilewich has quickly became our gold standard in waiting rooms, and the textural makeup provides real acoustical value—unlike LVT, which doesn't have an embossed layer. This is what led us to put in conference rooms as well."

The soft, woven textural surfaces of Chilewich textiles enhance acoustics by controlling echo and reducing reverberation. "We were amazed by the difference it made," says Nisbet. "It's not a flat surface, so sound doesn't bounce off it as readily."
